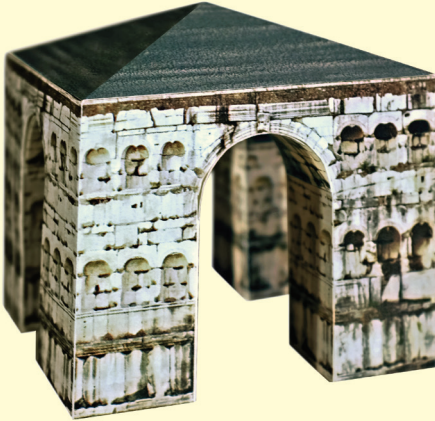


# Build Your Own Roman Arch
